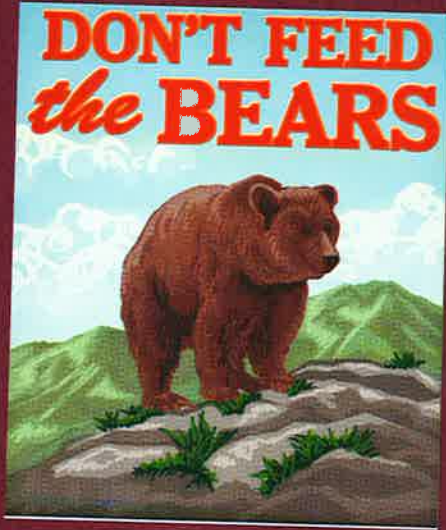




### Events
